Conditions

The client shall give Delta the corresponding safety data sheets of the filling good if requested. The client shall provide the empty IBC's free of charge, confirming that they comply with the following collection requirements:

1. The IBC must be as empty as practicably possible with washable residues. Unacceptable residues include but are not restricted to: ink, paint, adhesives, latex and resins.
2. A minimum of eight IBC's must be available for collection. Smaller quantities may be collected open agreement to additional transport charges.
3. All openings of the IBC are hermetically closed with the original valve, lids and caps in place.
4. The IBC must not be damaged, i.e. the cage and pallet must not be deformed, broken or rusted and the inner bottle not be punctured or otherwise damaged.
5. The last filling good for which the IBC was used must be clearly identified; the corresponding labels / stickers indicating the filling good, the markings of hazardous goods and indications of hazardous material must be legible.

By signing this agreement you confirm Delta has the right to charge appropriate wasted transport costs should IBC's not be available for collection at the agreed collection date. You further agree if IBC's collected are found not to fulfil the above conditions Delta has the right to charge for the disposal of non-compliant containers at the rate of £25.00* per container. Additionally Delta has the right to charge for the safe disposal of residue exceeding 0.5% volume. Alternatively IBC's will be returned at the clients expense.
